



Pico Mountain Resort's Academic Excellence Program

NEW Eligibility Requirements

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY THERE HAVE BEEN MANY CHANGES!

1. The program is now for **Pico Mountain Resort only**. For those Academic Excellence students who would like to ski at Killington there will be an option to upgrade to an Unlimited Killington Season Pass for \$99 + tax. All benefits however are for Pico Mountain Resort only and will not carry over to Killington. Additionally any Killington full price pass benefits will not apply to the Academic Excellence Pass.
2. New this year students who earned **Honors as well as High Honors** two out of four marking periods will qualify for this program. Eligibility is based on the student's grades in the *previous* school year (meaning: in grade 3 students are able to work towards qualifying for the pass starting in grade 4 and so on until 12th Grade, the last year of pass issuance). **1st, 2nd and 3rd Grade students will be given a complimentary Pico Mountain Resort Season Pass!** Passes will be awarded September 1, 2009 thru November 30, 2009 only. **Passes are not transferable and will not be issued after November 30, 2009. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. New benefits for Academic Excellence Students only include \$15 per day rentals and \$15 lessons (with space available) everyday except for all Saturdays and December 27, 2009, January 17, 2010 and February 14, 2010. There will be seasonal ski/board rental available for \$99 for the entire season. These benefits are for Pico Mountain Resort only and do not include Killington.
4. Schools in Rutland, Windsor, Addison and Orange Counties may sign up with Pico Mountain Resort for the program.
5. Students must be currently enrolled at a participating school, and must have been enrolled in a participating school the previous year (or any other Vermont school).
6. Students must be year-round full time students of their participating school.
7. Schools must provide The AEP Coordinator with its lists of eligible students **BY EMAIL:** We prefer the lists to be sent by email to AcademicExcellenceProgram@killington.com. Lists can also be mailed to the attention of the Academic Excellence Program Coordinator at The Snowshed Sales Center 4763 Killington Road Killington, Vermont 05751.

8. Students must sign an Terms and Condition Agreement. Parents must sign the **Express Acceptance of Risks, Indemnification & Forum Selection Agreement** for anyone under the age of 18. Students 18 and up may sign without a parent or guardian. No exceptions!
9. **CREDIT/REFUND:** *No credit/refund of any kind will be issued to students who did **NOT** purchase a 2009/10 pass prior to obtaining an Academic Excellence Program pass (regardless of whether or not the privileges are being used).* Academic Excellence Program students that did, in fact, already purchase a 2009/10 Killington or Pico season passes will be issued a refund!
10. **AFTER confirmation by Pico Mountain Resort that we received the list of the qualifying students, your school coordinator may send out to the qualifying students the attached Academic Excellence Program Student Application Form, the Information Sheet for Schools/Parents, the Express Acceptance of Risk and the Family Day Discount information.**
11. Students who are eligible for free or reduced lunch at school will qualify for Free Rental Equipment at Pico Mountain Resort. The school needs to identify those students by placing an * behind their names.
12. All Students who qualify for Academic Excellence Program are eligible for one free beginners' ski or ride lesson at Pico Mountain Resort, which needs to be reserved by calling 1-800-923-9444.
